- ◆ **Assisted Voluntary Return and Reintegration (AVRR)** for migrants in their countries of origin

Capacity building



- ◆ **Adoption of a referral mechanism** with procedural documents for the identification, screening and referral of migrants
- ◆ **Development of Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs)** to facilitate the screening and the identification of potential beneficiaries of the AVRR programme

Registration, documentation and Refugee Status Determination (RSD)



- ◆ **Refugee Status Determination** for asylum seekers registered by UNHCR in Algeria

Child protection



- ◆ **Best Interest Assessment Determination** for vulnerable unaccompanied, separated children at risk

Capacity building



- ◆ **Cooperation, coordination and training activities** addressing national counterparts sensitized on international protection law and principles

Direct assistance



- ◆ **Reinforcement and broadening of protection services** for the most vulnerable asylum-seekers and urban refugees
