### Areas of Intervention

#### Direct humanitarian assistance



- ◆ **distribution of non-food items, food and water** to vulnerable migrants
- ◆ **medical, psychological and livelihood support** for migrants in need
- ◆ **assistance to the voluntary return** and reintegration of migrants to their countries of origin
- ◆ **enhance of reception conditions** in the N'Djamena airport and in two medical clinics in Faya and Moussoro

#### Capacity building



- ◆ **development of a training guide** on national legislative and institutional Chadian frameworks on services provision to migrants and on identification, referral and protection of vulnerable migrants
- ◆ **specialised trainings** for security and law enforcement officers and Chadian authorities based on the guide on human rights and protection principles

### Main results achieved in phase 4 until January 2021

**229** **vulnerable migrants** received emergency assistance including food, water, shelter and critical non-food items.

**104** **migrants** received psychosocial counselling support and medical assistance.

**85** **third-country nationals** have been assisted to return to their country of origin.

**599** **migrants** have been reached through awareness sessions to be informed of the assistance available.

**4** **infrastructures** renovated and equipped

**1** **training guide** on services provision for migrants developed

## Areas of Intervention

### Child Protection



- ◆ **psychosocial support** and recreational activities for migrant children
- ◆ **assistance to young migrants** through vocational trainings and capacity building activities on entrepreneurship

### Capacity building



- ◆ **training for social assistants, operators and judges** in the field of child protection, family tracing and family reunification
- ◆ **training for law enforcement officers** on migrants' protection

### Awareness raising



- ◆ **awareness raising for leaders** of local communities on the protection of migrant children
- ◆ **awareness raising for children, parents, youngsters** and for communities on the risks related to unsafe child migration
- ◆ **awareness raising for teachers** on the protection of migrant children and on the prevention of risks related to unsafe child migration

## Main results achieved in phase 4 until November 2020

**263** **children at risk or on the move** received protective services through UNICEF-supported programs.

**1** **standard operating procedure** for the selection of host families have been developed and endorsed by the Ministry of Women and Childhood Protection.

**22** **new community-based mechanisms** were established in Borkou and Ouaddai

**1,378** **people** including decision makers at all levels, have increased awareness on issues related to children on the move
