

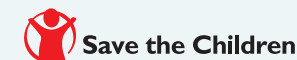

Areas of Intervention

Direct assistance



- ◆ **Medical referral, psychological support and legal assistance** to migrants
- ◆ **Distribution of non-food items kits**
- ◆ **Assisted Voluntary Return and Reintegration (AVRR)** for adults and unaccompanied minors in their countries of origin
- ◆ **Adoption of a referral mechanism with procedural documents** for the identification, screening and referral of migrants

Capacity building



- ◆ **improvement of migration governance** and protection of the rights of the migrants in transit by the Government and by Tunisian civil society

Awareness raising



- ◆ **dissemination of information** for migrants on the assistance services available in Tunisia

Main results achieved in phase 1 until April 2019

1,065 brochures on migrants' rights distributed	6,000 leaflets on AVRR disseminated
1,344 migrants benefitted from medical assistance	3,909 migrants received assistance services/ individual counseling
2,206 migrants received non-food items	210 migrants benefitted from AVRR Programme
597 migrants participated in recreational activities	15 family tracing and assessment activities conducted
536 migrants benefitted from IOM individual legal advice	10 meetings of best interest determination panel were organized and 18 cases of unaccompanied migrant children (UMCs) discussed
9 trainings and 75 coordination meetings organized	1 hotline toll-free service set up
16 awareness-raising sessions organized for the benefit of 241 migrants and community leaders;	5,553 migrants assisted through a hotline service

Main results achieved in phase 3 until December 2020

2,085 migrants receiving individual counselling through the MRRMs counsellors in Tunis, Sfax and Zarzis	26 migrants assisted through AVRR services
3,658 migrants assisted with adapted services	1 hotline toll-free service set up
2,528 migrants received non-food items	10,100 calls received on the hotline
6 recreational activities organized for migrants	450 migrants benefitted from individual counselling by the MRRM mobile teams

Main results achieved in phase 3 and 4 until December 2020

21 **Tunisian minister-level officials** participated to study visits in France and Sweden

734 **RSD cases** were adjudicated from January 2019 to December 2020

934 **cases** on refugee status processed from January 2019 to December 2020

6,355 **asylum seekers and refugees** were registered with UNHCR as of Dec 2020, with 3,237 newly registered in 2020
