



Call for Curricula for a position as Consultant

For the establishment of a Consultants' roster

CinemArena Campaign

CFCV 2023 05

Context

In the framework of the project "CinemArena" – *The itinerant education and information programme raising awareness on socio-economic opportunities and promoting empowerment in Africa as alternative to irregular migration (2022-2025)*, a roster of consultants will be created to assist the Project Manager in Italy to coordinate the activities of the mobile cinema in the target countries. Selected candidates will be part of the roster and they will be contacted as requested.

CinemArena is a "mobile cinema" providing a set of outdoor events, organized in rural and urban areas, with projection of films, documentaries and testimonies. The aim is to ensure outreach and to carry out educational and information campaigns in the most remote and disadvantaged migration-prone areas. Specifically, the project will raise awareness on socio-economic opportunities and promote empowerment as alternatives to irregular migration in five North and West African countries (Cote d'Ivoire, Guinea, Senegal, The Gambia and Tunisia).

The project will be implemented through an itinerant campaign which will cross each target country between January 2023 and May 2025. The campaign will be organized with the support of IOM team, international and national experts, facilitators, artists, returnees, service providers, as well as governmental and non-governmental partners. During the campaign, awareness raising screenings and entertainment activities will be organized as well as open days, trainings and competitions with local partners for youth and at-risk communities.

Selected consultants will be part of the CinemArena roster and they may be contacted as necessary within the period January 2023 - May 2025 to implement the activities of the mobile cinema Campaign for one or two months (depending on availability and context needs) in one of the five target countries (Cote d'Ivoire, Guinea, Senegal, The Gambia and Tunisia).

TERMS OF REFERENCE

Nature of the consultancy: Expert services on information and education campaigns to IOM in partnership with the Directorate General for Italians Abroad and Migration Policies (DGIT).

Objective: The consultant is required to assist the Project Coordinator in the development of the CinemArena information and education campaign that will be carried out in partnership the Directorate General for Italians Abroad and Migration Policies (DGIT).

Target: Cote d'Ivoire, Guinea, Senegal, The Gambia, Tunisia

IOM Project to which the Consultancy is contributing: “CinemArena” – The itinerant education and information programme raising awareness on socio-economic opportunities and promoting empowerment in Africa as alternative to irregular migration” funded by the Directorate General for Italians Abroad and Migration Policies (DGIT).

Tasks to be performed:

The consultant is required to assist the Project Coordinator in the target countries in the following activities:

- Coordinate with the Project Coordinator the organization of at least 25 outdoors events per month in the target country, in close coordination with the project team and dedicated staff;
- Support the CinemArena project team in Italy and in the target country, in coordinating different actors (local authorities, audience, NGOs, associations, employment institutions, actors of theatre and artists) including those who will participate and intervene in the evening debates organized by CinemArena;
- Support the CinemArena project team in Italy and in the target country in the implementation of various activities related to the Campaign (including dissemination of information material, collection of feedback, promotion of vocational trainings etc.);
- Provide support for the preparation, installation and dismantling phases during each event;
- Provide multimedia material of ongoing activities to IOM (photos/videos/interviews).

Tangible and measurable output of the work assignment:

- The events in the target country are successfully organized and implemented, targeting the most marginalized and most affected communities;
- Local actors, authorities and international media are promptly informed about CinemArena activities and their impacts;
- Target beneficiaries are promptly informed about CinemArena activities through dissemination of information material to be distributed before and during the events.

Details as to how the work must be delivered:

- Ensure, together with the IOM Mission in Italy and in the target country, a wide dissemination of educational messages to the most marginalized and vulnerable populations, increasing their awareness on risks related to irregular migration as well as on the relevant policies and the alternative opportunities promoted by local governments and authorities.
- Upon completion of the task, the Consultant will provide to IOM Italy a specific report on the assignment and its outcomes, offering observations on the impact of the events carried out in the target countries.

Performance indicators for evaluation of results:

- 25 events per month organized in the target country
- More than 10.000 participants per month sensitized

Required Qualifications and Experience:

Education

- University or Master's degree in political science, management, human rights, development, social science or a related field from an accredited academic institution and/or one year of relevant professional experience in the related field; and/or
- Certificate in video making, photography, theatre or related field from an accredited academic institution and/or one year of relevant professional experience in the related field.

Experience

- Experience in working in a team is required;
- Experience in development contexts and/or in the field of migration is an advantage;
- Knowledge of migrations issues is required;
- Interest and strong motivation in working in Africa on information campaign is appreciated.

Skills

- Flexibility in working in challenging environments;
- Strong skills in communicating with people of different backgrounds and in supporting the team;
- Excellent adaptability to the context;
- Good photography and/or video making skills are appreciated.

Languages

- Fluency in Italian and English and/or French.
- Knowledge of both English and French will be considered as an asset.
